1. The establishment of the Battalion Headquarters comprised the commanding officer, second-in-command, adjutant and intelligence officer. The Quarter-Master, Medical Officer and Chaplain were included within the strength of Headquarter Company.
2. In April 1940, the War Office authorized the increased in establishment of an infantry section from eight men to ten men. This comprised the Corporal commanding the section, a Lance Corporal who was responsible for the Bren Gun group of a Number 1 and Number 2. The other six men formed the rifle group of the section. Although this was authorized in April 1940, accounts seem to suggest that most battalions in the B.E.F. in France were unable to take advantage of the increased establishment before the German forces invaded France and the Low Countries on the 5th May 1940.
