



## NOTES:

1. The actual breakdown of the personnel within the Group Headquarters is not confirmed. The known personnel are:
  - Commanding Officer;
  - Second-in-Command;
  - Adjutant;
  - Quarter-Master;
  - Regiment Medical Officer (on attachment from R.A.M.C.).
2. This number of personnel with each company is not confirmed, but was approximately five-hundred African Other Ranks (AORs) as a third of the total number within each Auxiliary Group.
3. The Company Headquarters comprised:
  - Company Commander (Offr);
  - Company Officer (second-in-command) (Offr);
  - Company Sergeant Major (European Non-Commissioned Officer (ENCO));
  - Company Quarter-Master-Sergeant (European Non-Commissioned Officer (ENCO))The rest of the personnel were African Other Ranks (AORs).
4. Each platoon was commanded by a European subaltern, either a Lieutenant or Second Lieutenant. Most were British, although several Polish and few Czechoslovak officers also served in the West African divisions. Each platoon had a European (mainly British) Platoon Sergeant (ENCO) and an African Sergeant (ANCO). The sections were all African Other Ranks.
5. It is assumed that each group must have had a Signals Platoon.
