1. A Regular Army cavalry regiment, this unit was based at Canterbury in Kent.
2. This Regular Army regiment was based at Shorncliffe in Kent.
3. A Regular Army unit, this cavalry regiment was based at Colchester. It moved to Aldershot in 1931 and then two years later it moved to Hounslow. In September 1935, the regiment travelled to Egypt where it was stationed at the outbreak of war.
4. This Regular Army regiment was based at Hounslow, Middlesex. It left for Egypt later in the year, from where it travelled on to India in 1932. It returned to the United Kingdom at the beginning of September 1939 returning to Eastern Command. It later joined the 1st Motor Machine Gun Brigade in France, which became the 26th Armoured Brigade.
5. This battalion of the Royal Tank Corps was based at Lydd in Kent.
6. In 1917, the 96th Brigade, Royal Field Artillery was formed. After the Great War, this regiment became the 8th Field Brigade. The headquarters and four batteries were all stationed in Brighton. Although under Eastern Command for administrative purposes, operationally this brigade formed part of the 2nd Division based at Aldershot.
7. This brigade and all constituent batteries were based at Shoeburyness, Essex.
8. The Riding Establishment, Royal Artillery was based at the home of the Royal Artillery at Woolwich.
9. The detachment was stationed at Norwich.
10. The Signals Experimental Establishment was based at Woolwich, with No. 4 Wireless Company at Chatham and Eastern Command Signals based in London with the Headquarters, Eastern Command.
11. The Royal Army Service Corps units were based around the command area. The 17th, 37th, 38th and 'F' Companies were all stationed at Woolwich; the 18th Company was based at Chatham; the 20th and 'B' Companies were at Kensington Barracks, London W.8; the 21st Company was at Colchester; the 22nd Company at Shorncliffe; with the 'R' Company, M.T. and Vehicle Reserve Depot all located at Feltham in Middlesex.
12. The 9th Company, R.A.M.C. was based at Colchester; with the 10th Company at Shorncliffe; the 12th Company at Woolwich and 18th Company at Millbank Barracks, London S.W.1.
13. The R.A.O.C. sections were based at Chatham (No. 6); Dover (No. 7) and Colchester (No. 8) respectively.
14. The No. 1 (Depot) Section of the R.A.V.C. was based at Woolwich, with the other detachments based at the location of their title.
15. The Royal Army Pay Corps detachments were based as their titles suggest.
