Corps of Military Police (17)

1. A Regular Army cavalry regiment, this unit was based at Hounslow, Middlesex. It was under command of the 2nd Division at Aldershot as the divisional reconnaissance regiment.
2. This Regular Army regiment was based at Shorncliffe in Kent. It formed part of the 1st Division at Aldershot as the divisional reconnaissance regiment.
3. This battalion of the Royal Tank Corps was based at Lydd in Kent. By this date, the 1st Tank Brigade had been formed at Aldershot, and this battalion now formed part of this formation.
4. This Regular Army battalion had been stationed overseas since 1919. It had served on Malta, moving to Turkey as part of the army of occupation in 1920. In 1922, it moved to India, being deployed on internal security duties and on the North West Frontier. It then moved to the Sudan in 1935 before returning to the U.K. in 1936. It was stationed at Warley in Essex, being administered by the 11th Infantry Brigade but formed part of the 14th Infantry Brigade stationed at Catterick Camp.
5. The headquarters and four batteries were all stationed in Colchester.
6. This field brigade and all constituent batteries were based at Norwich. It had been formed in 1936.
7. This field brigade was formed in 1936 as an army field brigade, ie, not under command of a divisional formation. The headquarters and three batteries were all stationed at Brighton and came under Aldershot Command for training purposes.
8. The medium brigade was stationed at Shoeburyness.
9. The Riding Establishment, Royal Artillery was based at the home of the Royal Artillery at Woolwich.
10. The detachment was stationed at London.
11. The Signals Experimental Establishment was based at Woolwich, with No. 8 Artillery Signal Section and No. 10 Artillery Signal Section at Canterbury and Eastern Command Signals based in London with the Headquarters, Eastern Command.
12. The Royal Army Service Corps units were based around the command area. The 37th, 45th and 'F' Companies were all stationed at Woolwich; the 18th Company was based at Chatham; the 22nd and 46th Companies at Shorncliffe; with the M.T., Vehicle Reserve Depot and driving school all located at Feltham in Middlesex.
13. The 9th Company, R.A.M.C. was based at Colchester; with the 10th Company at Shorncliffe; the 12th Company at Woolwich and 18th Company at Millbank Barracks, London S.W.1.
14. The R.A.O.C. sections were based at Dover (No. 7) and Colchester (No. 8) respectively.
15. The No. 1 (Depot) Section of the R.A.V.C. was based at Woolwich, with the other detachments based at the location of their title.
16. The Royal Army Pay Corps detachments were based as their titles suggest.
17. There were seven sections from the Corps of Military Police stationed across the command. There were two sections at Shorncliffe and Woolwich, and one each at Colchester, Dover and Chatham.
